

Seachtain na Gaeilge



An Tóráíocht Taisce

First years are invited to compete in *An Tóráíocht Taisce* today (Monday 10 March) as part of *Seachtain na Gaeilge*. This is a treasure hunt, where *an taisce*, the treasure, is a basket of thirty delicious crème eggs!

Teams may consist of as many members as you like, including students who do not study Irish, but one person must be chosen as *cinnire*. The *cinnire* must come to O3 in the Old Block at 12.55 pm to collect a list of clues, which will be *as Gaeilge*.

All the clues refer to places in the school. The competitors go to the places and announce the answer loudly, for example if the clue refers to the library, they go there and call out "*an Leabharlann*". Some senior students there will give them a letter written on a piece of paper.

When they have collected all the letters, the team must decide what word is spelt by the letters. There is a clue on the clue sheet to help them.

Then the *cinnire* and his/her team must come over to O3 and spell out the word with the letters for Ms Nic Ruairí. The first successful team wins *an taisce*. There is no second prize.
